O primeiro volume da versão em e-book equivale à primeira metade da versão impressa em formato big e mostra o começo da história da androide e a primeira batalha da heroína contra Makaku, um ciborgue assassino viciado em endorfina. Para sustentar seu vício, Makaku tenta sugar o cérebro de quem aparece na sua frente. A luta não vai ser nada fácil, pois a garota logo descobre que Makaku é mais cruel do que ela imaginava.

A interminável batalha de Alita continua. Sem poder escapar de seu destino de lutas sem fim, a garota que se revoltou com o domínio da cidade aérea de Zalem vence a batalha contra o cientista insano Desty Nova. Porém, logo em seguida, Alita é pega desprevenida em uma cilada.
