Environmental, health and sanitary requirements in developed countries are perceived in developing countries as non-tariff barriers to trade. This book shows that such restrictions are perceived to be more stringent during the domestic production season. It also argues that scientific data for specific thresholds appear to be questionable.

Pursuant to a congressional request, GAO reviewed the Department of State's criteria and methodology for compiling the list of countries that prohibit crewmembers aboard U.S. vessels from performing longshore activities in U.S. ports. GAO found that: (1) in December 1992, State published a list of 63 countries that restrict longshore work by crewmembers aboard U.S. vessels; (2) although State's criteria for placing countries on the list depend upon the host government's restrictions on longshore work, it does not place countries on the list if they have not enforced their restrictions on longshore activities; (3) although State's narrow interpretation of the legislation is legally supportable, its position on nonenforcement and ship calls is not supported by the legislation; (4) State collects its information on the host countries' laws, regulations, and practices affecting longshore work through its overseas posts; (5) some of State's decisions on individual countries appear arbitrary because the information it collects does not enable it to fairly apply its criteria for placing countries on the list, have a uniform reporting format, and identify the frequency of port calls by U.S. vessels; and (6) State officials have acknowledged that there are difficulties in obtaining the necessary data for determining which countries should be included on the list.
