Het boek ziet op de doorbreking van de natrekking in rechtsvergelijkend perspectief, waarbij een 4-tal rechtsstelsels met elkaar worden vergeleken. De rechtsstelsels betreffen het Duitse, het Nederlandse, het Belgische alsook het Schotse rechtsstelsel en worden ieder in een apart hoofdstuk beschreven. Alvorens in te gaan op de wijzen waarop de natrekking kan worden doorbroken, wordt ingegaan op het criterium waaraan voldaan dient te worden wil van natrekking sprake zijn. Natrekking treedt doorgaans in wanneer het object 'duurzaam met het grondstuk is verenigd'. Of aan dit criterium wordt voldaan hangt af van het rechtsstelsel dat aan de onderliggende natrekkingsscasus ten grondslag ligt, nu de reikwijdte van de objectieve maatstaven die aan dit criterium ten grondslag liggen per rechtsstelsel verschilt.

Land law is now under the legislative competence of the Scottish Parliament. With the abolition of feudal tenure under the Land Tenure Reform (Scotland) Act 2000, this is once again a topical area. Reference is made to reforms and also to recommendations from the Scottish Law Commission, and areas such as management and use of common property, statutory protection, boundaries and liferents are covered.
